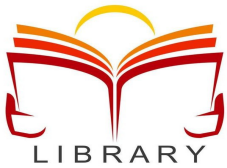
Beginning March 2, 2026, interest and late fees will be assessed to any accounts that remain unpaid.

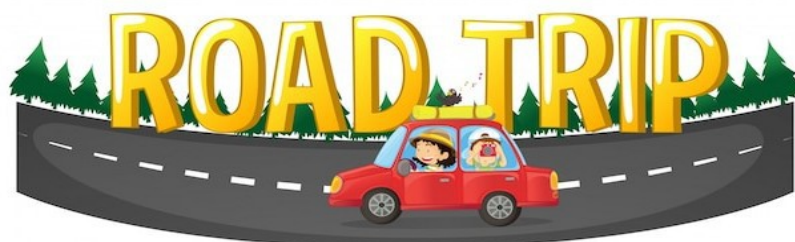
